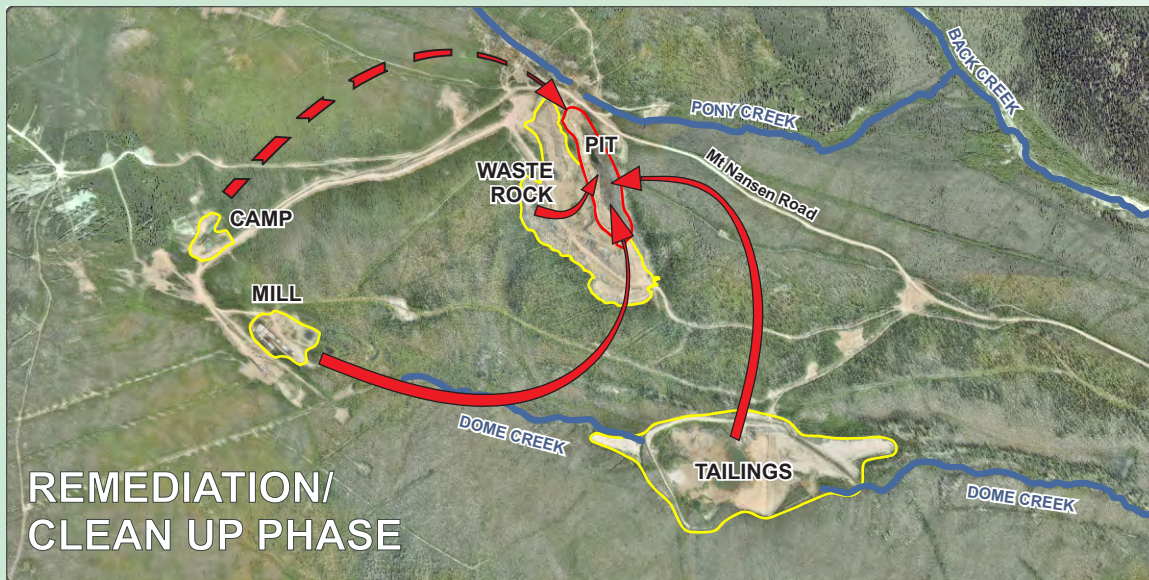

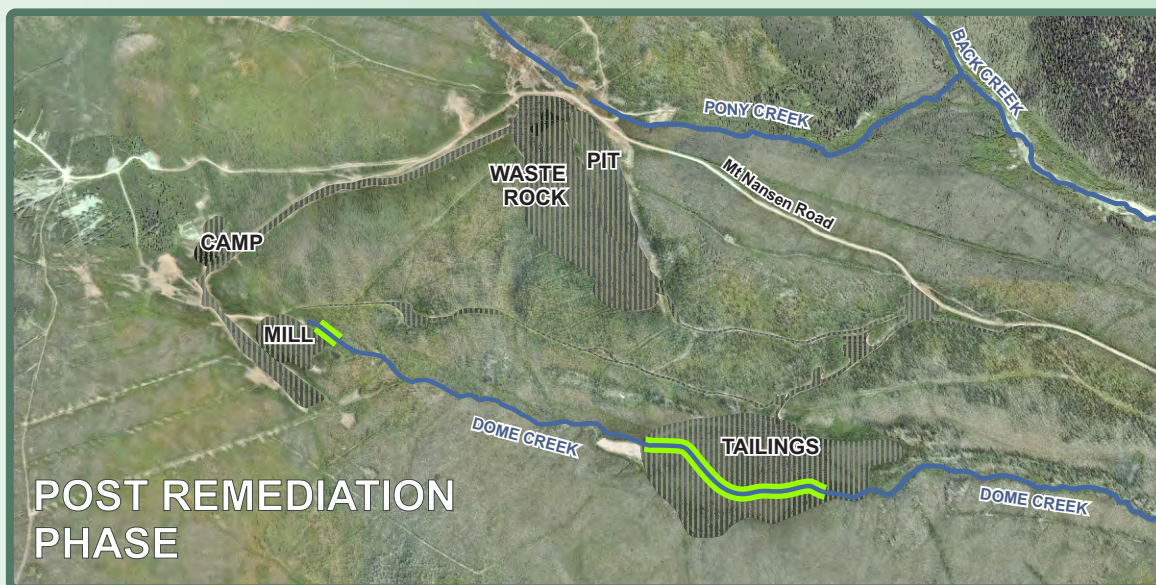

*Mine tailings, waste rock and other waste material will be placed in the open pit and covered with an engineered barrier liner system.*

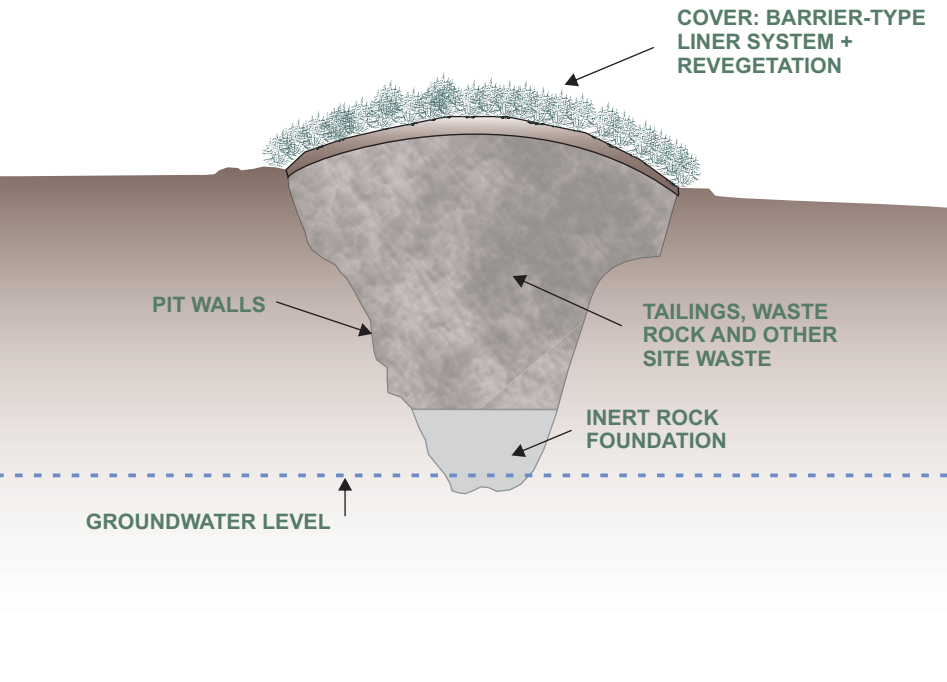
*Dome Creek will be restored, and the site will be re-vegetated with native plant species.*

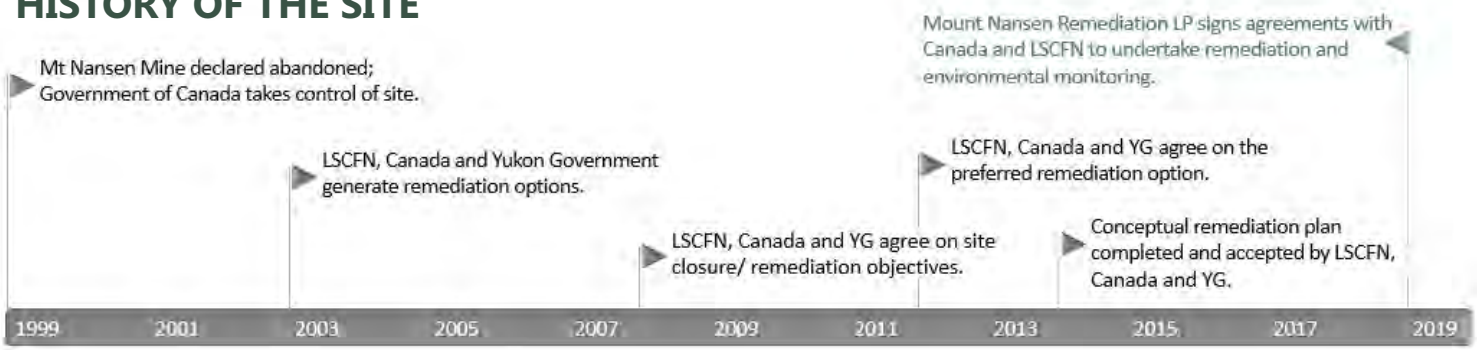
